



Please refer 3.1.2 (Sl.No.1, p.25) regarding evaluation criteria: There should be distinction between writing a chapter of any Economic Survey and preparation of the full Economic Survey Report. Here, both are treated as same. In such a case, an agency writing two chapters for the two states (one chapter for each state) will get more weightage than an agency preparing say, five reports in various years for one state. And hence, instead of number of states, it should be number of Economic Surveys prepared (may be for the same state an agency may prepare several reports in different years). Generally, Government of India prepares the Economic Survey internally and not contracted out, and hence it may be deleted.</p>	<p>Not Agreed</p>
<p>2. There is no clarity about the purpose of presentation of the proposal. Generally, for presentation only those applicants are invited who receive a threshold minimum based on evaluation criteria (say, 70 marks out of 100) and then due weightage is given to those who are invited for presentation. Presentation may consider a certain qualifying mark.</p>	<p>There is no provision of presentation.</p>
<p>3. There is no Appendix-11 attached in RFP as mentioned in the document (p.15 under 2.14.3).</p>	<p>No need of the said Appendix therefore sl no- of 2. 14.2 treated as null.</p>
<p>4. It is extremely difficult to deliver in 90 days both English and Hindi versions of the printed copies of the survey. The translation in Hindi itself will almost take one month. Hence, it is suggested that only summary of the Survey in Hindi along with English version should be mandated to be delivered in 90 days. The full Hindi version can be delivered in next 30 days.</p>	<p>Agreed</p>
<p>5. In the RFP, it is not specified whether the printed copies should be in multi-colour or single colour or whether it should be in art paper or ordinary paper.
